As a Clinical Laboratory Technologist, you will perform tests on specimens

from Mayo Clinic, its affiliated laboratory services, and from clinics and hospitals around the world. You will troubleshoot assays, evaluate tests for accuracy, and provide operational support activities to optimize testing. You may work in specialized laboratories that include highly skilled manual techniques or automated testing using sophisticated instrumentation. You will work independently and with other department members to provide efficient and accurate reporting of results. The work environment is fast-paced, allowing you to utilize your expert organizational and multitasking skills and to manage the pressure of time constraints.

Qualified candidates must be a graduate or a student graduating within six months with a Bachelor's degree in a biological science, chemistry, medical laboratory science (MLS), clinical laboratory science (CLS), or medical technology (MT). A Bachelor's degree plus certification in MLS, CLS, or MT as recognized by the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Science (NAACLS) is also accepted. A HEW certificate may be substituted for the specified degree.
